

2021 EDUCATION EXPENSES STRUCTURE

The current fee structure at our school requires education expenses to be paid for (or payment plans established) prior to the commencement of the 2021 school year. If you need to arrange a payment plan please contact the office.

These packs are to be collected from the Orbost Authorised Newsagency before 22nd January 2021.

Payment plans include Centrelink deductions (Centrepay) or arranged regular direct deposits.

To make it easier for parents, the school has set up for each student an Essential Education Pack.

The items that make up the education expenses are outlined below.
